



If you are thinking of taking your dog abroad this year and he does not have a Pet Passport you must plan well in advance. This process is lengthy and can take as long as six months before your intended return. Dogs and cats that qualify for the scheme have been able to travel abroad with their owners since March 2000. A Pet Passport allows your dog to return to the UK without having to spend seven months in quarantine. In order to qualify you must, amongst other things, have your pet micro chipped and vaccinated against rabies. Your vet will advise you and take you through the various stages.
